**AGENDA REVIEW**

**CANYON ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT**

Bryan Kimball reported the 300 E. project was finished by the elementary school. A future phase going up the canyon road is anticipated. Most of the work was done with monies from a grant. Right-of-way issues almost killed the project. Bryan is trying to pro-actively approach the next phase. First, is needed a survey to determine right-of-way issues and property line descriptions. Jones & DeMille submitted an estimate of \$2,700 to start a design. A UDOT grant is anticipated.

**FIRE PROTECTION**

In conjunction with the fire protection agreement, Kerry Steck briefed the Council on his thoughts regarding fireworks. Due to extremely dry conditions, Chief Steck recommended prohibiting fireworks within the City this year in order to protect the City as a whole.

Fire season is closed for the State as of the first of June. The only fires permitted are for marshmallows or hot dogs in a contained fire ring.
