EPHRAIM HAS TWO NEW SUMMER REQUIREMENTS FOR 2014



Fireworks: The Ephraim City Council has decided that while it is a very dry year, Ephraim residents will be permitted to set off fireworks for the 4th of July; however,

fireworks will be banned for the rest of summer beginning July 7th unless revoked by the City Council.

We hope you have a great 4th of July this year and have lots of fun with your fireworks. Please be mindful of dry vegetation and keep safety a priority.

Open Burning: As per request of the Ephraim City Fire Chief, Kerry Steck, the City Council has banned all open burning between now and September 1st without a written permit from the Chief. This will include fires in fire pits.

With the extreme dry conditions, we want to make sure all those in the City remain safe from the dangers of fire.

SEWER RATE INCREASE TO FUND SEWER EXPANSION

In order to provide the necessary infrastructure for the city to continue to grow into the future, the city is expanding the sewer treatment system, as it is currently nearing full capacity.

The expanded facilities will treat up to 1.2 million gallons per day by adding a new 18 acre holding

pond and a small treatment facility that allows the water to be treated and recycled for agricultural use on land recently purchased for this project. The total cost of the project is estimated at approximately \$2.5M, which will be paid by a combination of user fees, impact fees, grants, and loan.

The sewer rates were raised by \$3.50 per household to \$27 for minimum monthly sewer charges. The rate change was approved by the city council on June 5, 2013 to become effective on July 1, 2014. The proposed expansion is expected to begin construction later this summer.

EQUAL PAY FOR UTILITY PAYMENTS

Every year in June Equal Pay amounts are re-calculated. If you are a current Equal Pay customer please be aware of the change on your bill.

Equal pay is a program offered to all Ephraim City residents who have a good utility payment history (i.e. payments have been made on time and in full for eleven out of twelve months)

Equal Pay amounts are calculated based on the average of the past twelve utility bills. If you qualify for this program you are required to continue to pay your bill in full and on time (due the 16th of the month). You are also expected to keep track of your account balance amount to pre-

vent it from getting too high or too low. If you are currently an Equal Pay customer and you do not know where to keep track of this on your bill, please contact us.

Equal Pay customers will see a change in their bill amount this month.

Along with re-calculating Equal Pay, we will be doing an audit of existing Equal Pay cus-

tomers. This audit will be done twice a year, in June and December. We are looking to verify the continuation of good payment history, payments that are made on time, as well as a credit/debit amount that is within a reasonable range. If it is found that you are not abiding by these requirements you will be notified via letter informing you that you have been taken off of the equal pay program.
