## “YOUR FAMILY & MONEY” A FREE COMMUNITY COURSE

This is a free community family finance course that will be taught every Thursday evening in April. Participants are expected to attend all four classes in April (3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th).

This unique and practical community course is designed to influence a married couple’s behavior and attitudes of money, and how these attitudes and behaviors influence many different aspects of family life. Participants’ current perspectives of money will be challenged, and differing philosophies will be addressed.

Participants will be guided through the process of developing a money strategy and spending plan, destroying debt (guerrilla warfare style), methods of investing, basics of insurance, taxes, social (in)security, how to teach children about

money, how to improve marital communication, and more. Perhaps the greatest benefits might be gaining a sense of direction with money, finding financial hope and peace for the future, learning essential skills, and coming together with increased marital unity regarding family finances—ALL WITHOUT THE INSTRUCTOR TRYING TO SELL ANYTHING! Usually community money classes are taught by people who desperately want to sell something. Not this time. Seating is limited, so participants should register ASAP to guarantee a seat. Free childcare is also limited, so participants must request childcare while registering (the first 20 children will be accepted).

If participants are married, it is recommended that they both register and attend all four Thursday evening classes together. Those who are single, divorced, or widowed are also strongly encouraged to register.

## NEW DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR SPORTS TEAMS

It is proposed that once sign-ups are over, the Recreation Director will distribute a list of registrants to each Head Coach. Kids will be evaluated on a scale of 1-3 with 3 being highest (athletic), 2 (somewhat athletic), and 1 (knows the sport but needs improvement). Coaches and the Recreation Director will put all #3 players on teams equally across the board, followed by 2's and 1's in the same manner.

Once the draft is complete, coaches will pick a team from a hat. His child will automatically go on that team. The head coach will then pick an assistant from the parents of his team members.

This proposal was discussed and adopted by the Recreation Board in the February Board Meeting. The purpose of this new Draft Proposal is to better serve the kids in the community, giving all an opportunity to play on a competitive team.

Following the Community Baseball and Softball programs, all those who turn eight before April 30, 2014, may play on an All Star Team. Parents may choose whether or not to have their child considered for an All Star Team at the time they register.
