Where: Greenwood Student Center

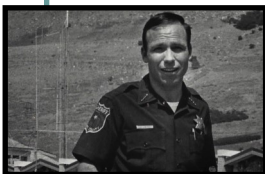

Open to all levels, all you need is your mat, your breath, and a desire to feel good! Instructor donations welcome. Mats available.



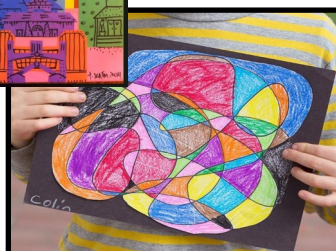
Film Feast: Peace Officer / Brad Barber + Scott Christopherson - Wednesday, November 7th at 7 p.m.
